

National Association Invitation

FIH HIGH PERFORMANCE COACHING COURSE at the FIH MEN'S WORLD CUP in INDIA (at Bhubaneswar)

National Associations (NA) and Continental Federations (CF) are invited to nominate individuals to attend this course, alongside the FIH Men's World Cup (Bhubaneswar).

Application process: Each NA/CF may nominate a maximum of 2 coaches (1 male + 1 female).

Selection criteria:

1. Hold a current FIH L4C Coach qualification or equivalent level issued by FIH member NA
2. Working with senior Top Club level or Junior / Senior National Team Programmes.
3. Coaches of National Age Group / Senior teams
4. Experience minimum of 7 years at a top national performance level (in past 10 years)
5. Consideration of universality (nations) and gender balance

Course content and layout: [See brochure](#). The Face-to-Face course starts at 19:30 on the 22 January 2023 and ends at 12:00 on the 28 January 2023, in Bhubaneswar.

Assessment process: Candidates will be formally assessed against FIH High Performance Coach competencies, as well as their readiness to attend a future FIH Final Coaching Course (HP 2).

Course outcome: At the end of this course candidates will have achieved one of three outcomes below. You will only receive the certificate once you complete all the course elements.

1. FIH Level 5 Coach certificate with recommendation to FIH Final Coaching Course (HP 2), if they are assessed as Excellent at this course
2. FIH Level 5 Coach certificate if they are assessed as Competent at this course
3. Participation certificate, for all other situations.

Language: Applicants should be an independent B2+ English speaker.

Participation fees: The participation fee is CHF 1865, which includes 6 nights full board accommodation in Bhubaneswar, all modules, face to face course at Bhubaneswar, e-learning module, 4 workshops and mentoring. All travel is the responsibility of the candidate.

Selection deadline: 21st December 2022. Candidates may be notified earlier.

Visa arrangements: You must check if you need a Visa to enter in India. You can find that information via the Indian embassy or consulate in your country. If India does not have an official representation in your country, you must find that out via the closest official Indian representation. Should you need a Visa letter from FIH, you will need to ask for it as soon as you are notified of your selection.
